Vineyard Site	1/2 mile south of St. Helena on Lewelling Lane, an alluvial fan at the base of the western foothills
Soil	Bale gravelly loam
Vines	Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc on 110R rootstock
Trellis	Vertical, 7-wire; 5' x 9' vine spacing; cane pruned
Composition	95% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc
